The Sheet Metal Workers' Scholarship Fund awards 34 scholarships in the amount of \$6,000 per year for up to four years for full-time <u>undergraduate</u> study at any accredited college or university, including two scholarships which may be awarded to Mechanical Engineering and Architecture student for a total of \$54,000 over five years! The Sheet Metal Workers' Scholarship Foundation awards 20 one-year \$4,000 scholarships and the Joseph J. Nigro and Joey Nigro, Jr. Memorial one-year \$5,000 scholarships for <u>undergraduate</u> study at any accredited college or university.

Eligibility requires that an applicant be an active member, a covered employee or a dependent spouse or child under the age of 25 of a member or covered employee. The applicant must also be a full-time student or be accepted to be a full-time student at an accredited college or university.
